

# Reactions to Things that Remind People of Smoking

## **What is the purpose of the research study?**

To study how smokers respond to things that may remind them of smoking.

## **Who can participate in the study?**

This study is accepting men and women who:

- Are 18 to 64 years of age
- Are generally healthy
- Smoke cigarettes every day

## **What will participants be asked to do?**

The study consists of 3 study visits lasting 2–5 hours each, all within 1 week.

Participants will:

- Provide urine and breath samples
- Work on a task to get puffs from cigarettes
- Complete various written and computer-based thinking tasks
- Complete questionnaires about smoking and mood

## **Where is the study taking place?**

The NIDA Intramural Research Program is located on the Johns Hopkins Bayview campus in east Baltimore.

## **How much does it cost?**

There is no cost for participation.

## **Will I receive payment of some kind?**

All study participants will receive money for their participation in this study.
